DAY 1.

Arrival at your rural accommodation in Albarracín and free time to enjoy its medieval atmosphere.

Along the way, we'll learn interesting facts about the landscape until we reach the cave paintings, which have been designated a World Heritage Site. The afternoon is free for you to do some shopping in the village, such as cured meats, cheeses, or handicrafts.

After breakfast, we will take a stroll with our private guide through Albarracín, one of the most beautiful villages in Spain, so much so that it was the first town in Aragon to be designated a Listed Historic Site in 1961.
