## Private host

I'm Guillermo, I'll teach you all about our devotion to our Lady of Cabeza.

The Basilica and Royal Sanctuary of our Lady of Cabeza, built between 1287 and 1304 on the Cerro de la Cabeza, marks the place where the Virgin's image appeared in 1227. It was later transformed, notably in the 16th century by Andrés de Vandelvira.

Its pilgrimage, the second oldest in Spain with nearly 800 years of history, is known for its most emotional moments, such as the transfer of the image before the arrival of the pilgrims. You will also discover Úbeda and Baeza, two jewels of the province of Jaén.
