Stay in the historic Parador, a 12th-century fortress known as Castillo de Monterreal, a landmark of maritime defence and major historical events. Baiona was the first European port to receive news of the discovery of the New World, upon the arrival of La Pinta.

During your stay, wander through the cobbled streets of the old town, watch the daily fish auctions, and learn about shellfishing traditions with a local percebeira. Enjoy fresh seafood in a traditional tavern and taste excellent Albariño in a nearby winery.
