Sarria

DAY 1. SARRIA

Arrival at Santiago de Compostela Airport and transfer to Sarria. Free time to explore this charming town and collect your Pilgrim's credential.



Portomarín

DAY 2. TO PORTOMARÍN

This stage passes through the areas of Sarria, Paradela, and Portomarín, showcasing Romanesque heritage along paved paths, scenic trails, rural lanes, medieval bridges, and charming rustic crossings.



Palas de Rei

DAY 3. TO PALAS DE REI

This stage passes by several Romanesque churches, with the option to visit the Church of San Salvador in Vilar de Donas, as well as historic pilgrim hospitals and the notable Cruceiro de Lameiros.

Arzua

DAY 4. TO ARZUA

Between Leboreiro and Melide, the route passes through the village of Furelos, crossing its river via a medieval bridge before entering Melide. From there, the Camino continues through Boente and Castañeda on its way to Arzúa, renowned for its cheese-making tradition.



O Pino

DAY 5. TO O PINO

A comfortable way, with easier slopes and tracks always close to the N-547.

DAY 6. TO SANTIAGO

We're almost at our destination! Near Lavacolla, the route passes a stream where medieval pilgrims traditionally washed and purified themselves before arriving in Santiago de Compostela.
