The Parador is situated within the grounds of Cardona Castle, a unique 9th-century fortress built to protect the region from the Muslims. Cardona is also renowned for its natural features, such as the olive groves (which lay abandoned until less than a decade ago) and the Salt Mountain, a formation unique in the world that extends more than 2 kilometres deep. Escape to Cardona and soak up its history as you wander the streets of its historic centre, explore the galleries of the potash salt mines, savour fine olive oil, or distinguish the different grape varieties used to produce the wines of the Bages Designation of Origin.
